Without their help, none of these special spay/neuter and adoption programs would have been possible in NY and Pa. With their help, we have been able to spay and neuter thousands of animals.

We are again pleased to announce another wonderful opportunity available to residents of Waverly, NY this coming February 26, 27, 28. Free cat spay and neuter coupons will be distributed to eligible Waverly residents three days only on February 26, 27, 28 in conjunction with National Spay Day. Paws and Claws Society, in partnership with Gemini Farm and local veterinarians, will sponsor “**Cat Spay Day**” with funding from a private donor.

In recognition of the importance of spay/neuter, PACS Board of Directors have declared February 26, 2019 as Cat Spay Day in Waverly, NY.

Spaying and neutering helps dogs and cats live longer, healthier lives. Spaying eliminates the possibility of uterine or ovarian cancer, greatly reduces the incidence of breast cancer, while neutering eliminates testicular cancer and decreases the incidence of prostate disease. You will have a more affectionate companion who will be less likely to spray, mark territory, bite, roam, run away or get into fights. Spay/neuter reduces the number of animals needing services at shelters as well as the number euthanized.

Spay/neuter literally saves lives!!

Coupons redeemable for **free cat spay/neuter surgery** will be available to eligible Waverly, NY residents while supplies last. Eligible residents are senior citizens, disabled persons, low income individuals, and multi-cat caretakers residing in Waverly, NY.
